

Suggestions for Transitioning to a New School Experience

- *Be positive when you talk with your child about School. Say something like: "We've met your teachers, and we've visited the school. The teachers love children, and I know you'll have a fun time there!"*
- *Let your child know that you understand that he / she is sad about leaving you, but just like Dad or Mom goes to work, you go to school!*
- *Keep your explanations short, simple, and positive. If you talk about school too much, your child may become more anxious or nervous.*
- *Make sure you have visited before the first day of school. This will help in the transition process. Reinforce that the teachers are here to take care of them.*
- *Visitation Day at the beginning of school will allow time for you to be in class with your child. This will help in the transition process.*
- *The first few days of school, make your goodbyes brief and positive. If you look sad, or if you linger, it reinforces sadness or insecurities.*
- *Give a kiss, say goodbye, and leave. The teachers are skilled at helping the children acclimate and redirecting their thoughts to activities in the classroom. The teachers have loving arms and are exceptionally good at comforting children if there are separation problems. You may message the school later to check in.*
- *Read books this summer about going to school. One of my favorites is *The Kissing Hand* by Audrey Penn. Check out the library for more ideas!*
- *As suggested in *The Kissing Hand*, create a goodbye routine or tradition with your child.*
- *Your child may bring a picture of their family or a special lovey for the first few days of school. We ask you to keep toys at home unless we have a special occasion. We don't want toys lost or broken! This is a suitable time to illustrate that home toys are for home, and school toys are for school.*
- *Bring your child by in the summer months for a visit. The Play yard is available for use. We only ask that you are sure it is left in the same condition you found it and be sure the gates are closed! Also, I expect to be in the office on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays so you may come inside for a visit too!*





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TUITION SCHEDULE FOR THE 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR

Part-Day Options

Two part-days: 2's ONLY \$1850.00 per year, payable in 10 monthly installments of \$185.00

Three part-days: **3's ONLY** \$2800.00 per year, payable in 10 monthly installments of \$280.00

Full Day Options

****Three Full Days** \$3800.00 per year, payable in 10 monthly installments of \$380.00
****NEW**** Available to three-year-olds

Four Full Days \$4900.00 per year, payable in 10 monthly installments of \$490.00

Five Full Days \$6200.00 per year, payable in 10 monthly installments of \$620.00
