
The summer session in July was enjoyable! We wish to thank Mrs. Brzoska and Ms. Topor for all the hard work they put into the program to make it successful.

TUITION

Jean Schlapfer St. Paul's bookkeeper and Rachel Harrel, the Church Secretary, handle the tuition payments. You should have received the tuition schedule in the packet you received in the spring or at registration this summer. You should have already paid two month's tuition for September and October. If you haven't, then you are delinquent in payments. The church office phone number is (860)482-3555, if you have any questions. We now have a digital way to pay tuition too! You can inquire about this in the church office. Please make checks payable to "**St. Paul's**" and put your child's name and class he/she attends in the "memo section" of the check.

FORMS ON FILE

In the packet you received in the spring or at registration over the summer, there were some other forms that need to be completed. If you haven't already, please be sure return the completed forms into the office before the first day of school. The forms include the Parent Agreements, the Emergency Contact Form, and the Child's Health Record. The state requires these forms to be in your child's file as a licensing requirement. If you can't find it, please stop in to the church office or visit our website and get a new packet! Church office hours are M-F 9-4.

SCHOOL PARKING

Please park in the parking area closest to the school entrance area. DO NOT PARK along the curbs. This is a fire safety zone and needs to be kept clear in case of emergencies.

Please **DO NOT** leave children unattended in your vehicle while you drop-off or pick-up your child. If you anticipate a problem, please discuss it with your child's teacher so we can assist you with arrangements.

For safety, please hold your child's hand in the parking lot AT ALL TIMES.

DAYS AND DATES OF THE FIRST WEEK OF SCHOOL

Visitation Day is the first day that your child is scheduled to attend class at St. Paul's Hilltop Christian Early Learning Center. This session will be *one hour long*. Your child will attend this day accompanied by Mom, Dad or another designated adult. This will help transition your child into the program, give the children an opportunity to meet others in their class, and give the grownups an opportunity to meet others. The class routine will be different from a usual day due to the shortened time. Your child's usual schedule will begin the next scheduled day.

Monday, September 10, 2018—9:00-11:30 a.m.: MW 3 year olds

Tuesday, September 11, 2018—9:00-11:30 a.m: T/Th mixed age class

Tuesday, September 11, 2018—9:30-11:00 a.m. 2 year olds



2018-2019 ENROLLMENT

- We have a limited number of spaces available in the School Readiness class. Please note that the School Readiness class has income and residential guidelines in order for students to be included in that class.
- The T/Th 2 year old class is full. We have started a waitlist. We have room to open a second 2's class on M/W if we gain enough interest.
- There are spaces available in the T/Th mixed age class.

We are pleased to have welcomed many of last year's staff members back to Hilltop this fall!

Mrs. Michelle Miller and Mrs. Christina Brzoska will work together as co-teachers in the 2 and 3 year old classes. We are in the process of hiring an assistant to help them on Mondays and Wednesday in the 3 year old class. They worked together last year during Lunch Bunch, and I am certain they will make a great team!

We are excited to announce that the 2 year old class now has its very own classroom! They will meet at the far end of the Hilltop Hallway in room 8. It is a nice cozy room, with a lot of the furniture just the right size for 2 year olds!

In the room 4, Mrs. Nicole Sears, one of Hilltop's most beloved teachers will co-teach with Ms. Lauren Phelan. The four year old class meets on Monday/Wednesday/Friday, and we have created a mixed age class of 3 and 4 year olds who will meet on Tuesdays/Thursdays. Mrs. Laurie Chepiga will be the assistant in these classes.

All the way down the hall, our School Readiness class is co-taught by Mrs. Monica Valente and Mrs. Lezlie Fosbrook. We have hired Ms. Megan Roberts to assist these teachers during the morning session and Ms. Phelan will join the class after lunch. Mrs. Sears and Mrs. Miller will come into this classroom to provide coverage while the teachers take their lunch breaks.

Mrs. Sosnicki continues as the Director /Head Teacher of the school, now in her 12 year in this position. Besides her many administrative duties to attend to, she has trained to be our Music Together® Music Specialist! She will be leading your child's music classes each week. Though her schedule is quite busy, she always makes herself available to staff, children and parents when needed. If there are ever any concerns please feel free to stop by and speak with her. Her office hours will be Monday through Friday 8:30-4:30.
